**NOTICE TO ALL INSURANCE COMPANIES  
AUTHORIZED TO CONDUCT BUSINESS IN CONNECTICUT  
CONCERNING  
PAID FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE INSURANCE POLICY FORMS**

The purpose of this notice is for the Connecticut Insurance Department (“CID”) to alert insurance companies authorized to conduct business in Connecticut (collectively “Carriers”) that the coverage standards for paid family and medical leave products (“CT PFML policies”) established by the Paid Family and Medical Leave Insurance Authority have been amended pursuant to Public Act 24-5. Effective October 1, 2024 these standards will be expanded to provide coverage to sexual assault victims who satisfy certain requirements for leave.

In light of these changes, the CID has updated its guidance regarding CT PFML policies. The newly issued [CT PFML Policy Form Guidance](#) and [CT PFML Policy Form Checklist](#) replace the PFML Insurance Policy Filing Guidance Notice and PFML Insurance Policy Form Checklist, respectively, which were previously issued by the CID on November 17, 2021.

At this time the CID would also like to remind Carriers that legislative amendments, such as the one enacted by Public Act 24-5, trigger the need for Carriers with CT PFML policy forms that have previously been approved by the CID to file amendments through the System for Electronic Rate and Form Filing (“SERFF”). Amendments should be filed in accordance with the CT PFML Guidance.
